TERMS & CONDITIONS

Anyone signing this for agrees to the following terms & conditions:-

- Livestock grazing on Parish Common land is entirely at the discretion of the Parish Council.
- Any parishioners given permission to graze animals by the Parish Council must liaise with other livestock owners currently grazing their animals on the common.
- The Parish Council will retain contact details of livestock owners and these will be shared with other people grazing livestock on the common, as necessary.
- All livestock owners must provide 24/7 contact details for emergency use and arrange suitable cover in the event of their absence from the village.
- All livestock owners must ensure that their livestock are healthy, have had all the necessary inoculations and are safe to roam with other animals.
- The Parish Council accepts no responsibility for the safety of the animals, this is entirely at the owner's risk.
- Insurance (including public liability) of the animals is the owner's responsibility and the owners must accept all liability whilst on the common.
- Weekly accurate records of when the animals are on the common must be kept and passed to the council on request.
- All livestock owners grazing their animals on the common must work together to maintain the common at their own expense eg:- clearing ragwort, maintaining fences.
- Please note that the fences are of barbed wire construction.
- Failure to comply with any of the above Terms and Conditions may result in permission to graze being withdrawn
- In the event of the HLS being withdrawn, we anticipate the Parish Council issuing a charge for grazing.
